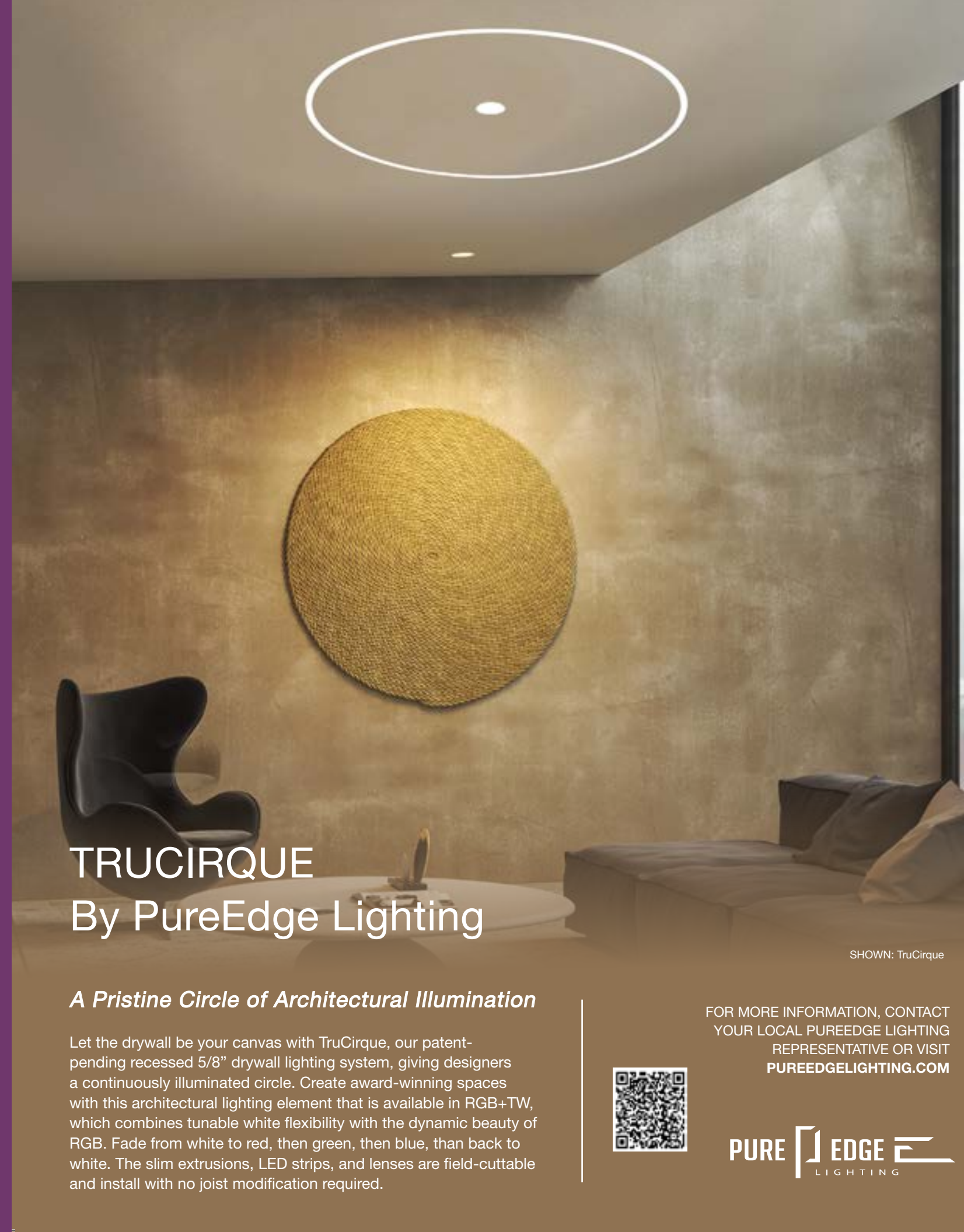

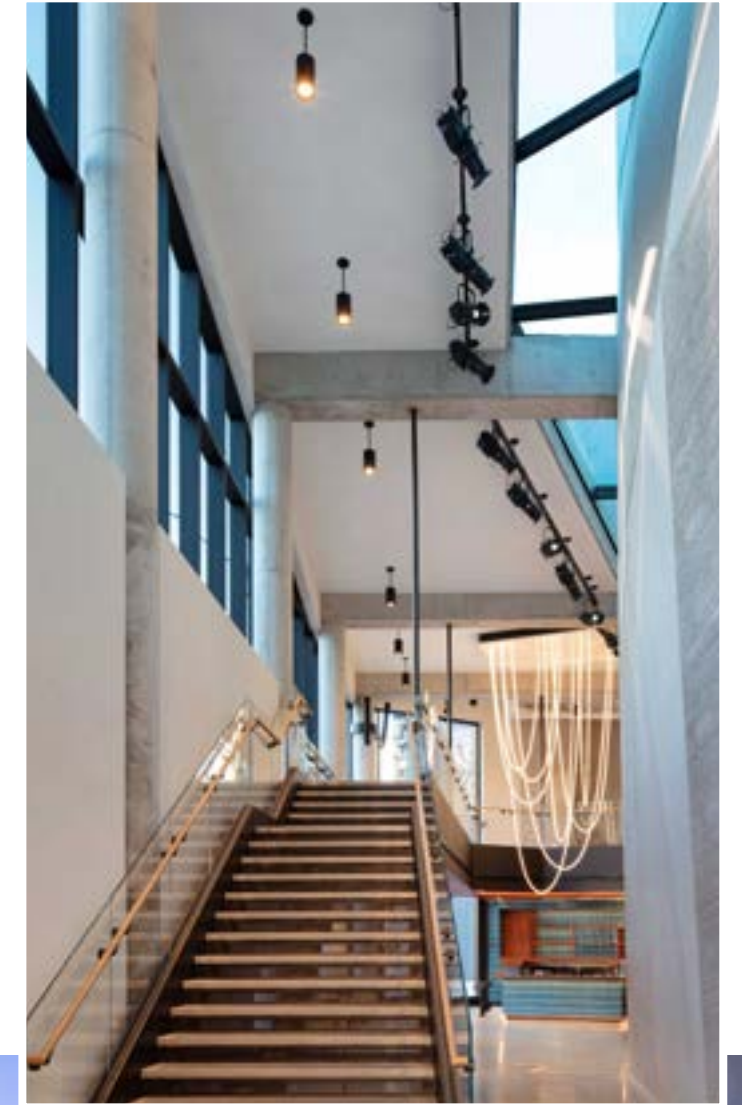

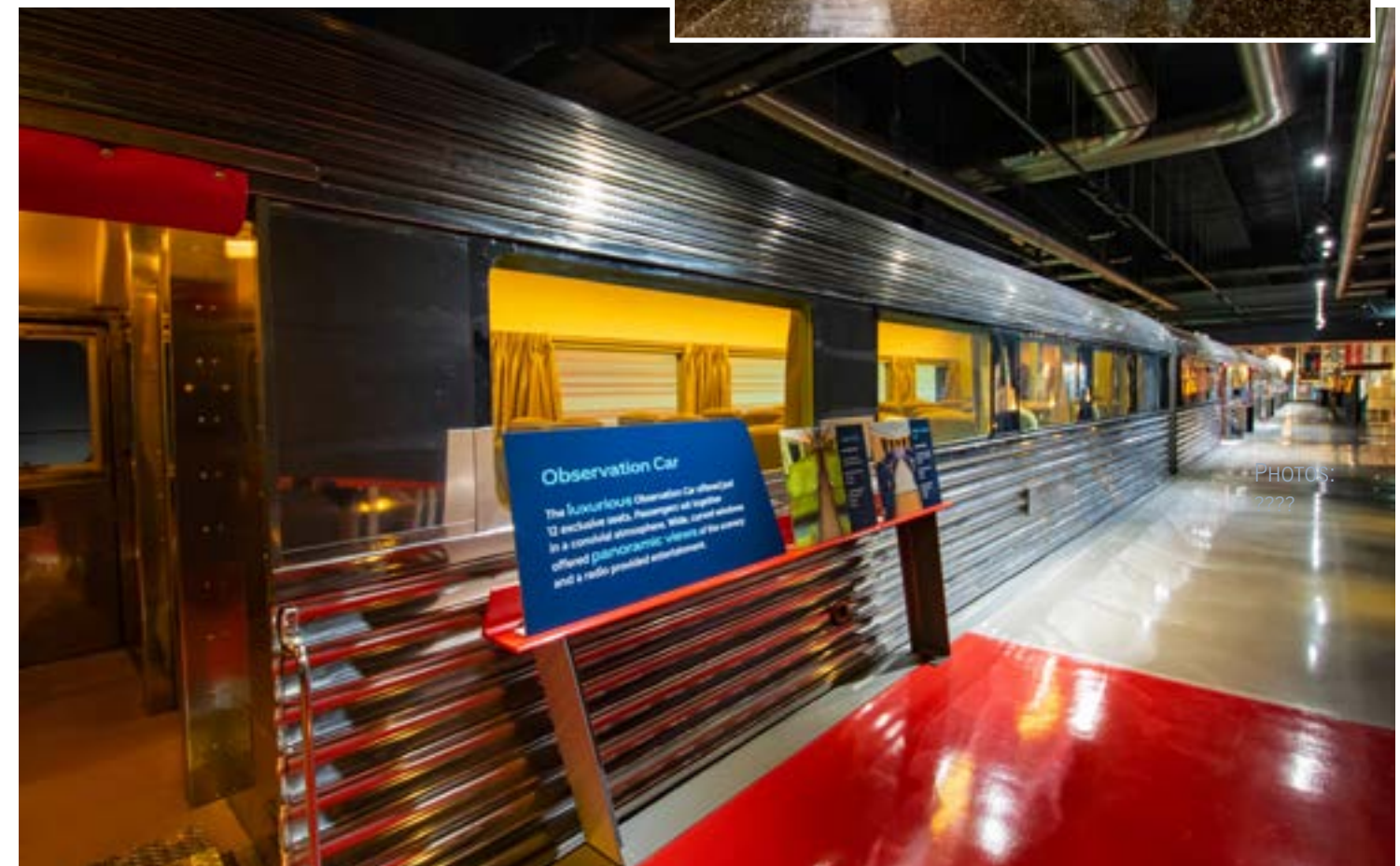

AWARD OF MERIT

**Northern Trust**

The new offices of Northern Trust required a thoughtful and comprehensive approach to design, supporting the major cultural shifts within the company, which called for more shared, sociable flexible spaces with daylight views, along with high-tech spaces with technological systems for daily operations. With different areas spanning across 17 floors, totaling roughly 500sq.ft, conforming to the client's design request presented a challenge for the entire design team, calling for prototypes to test new design ideas. This prototype-testing process allowed the project team to demonstrate available solutions to compare look-and-feel, functionality, and to resolve constructability challenges.

**SCHULER SHOOK**

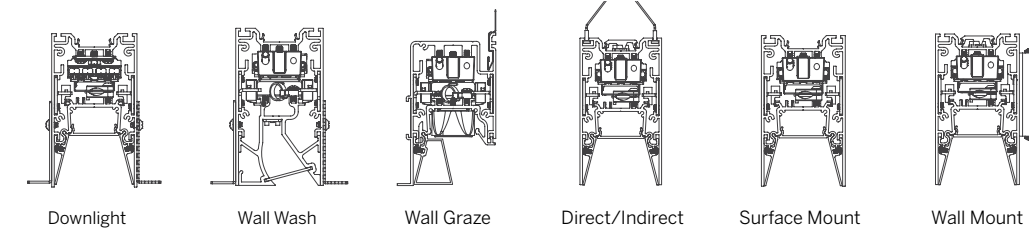
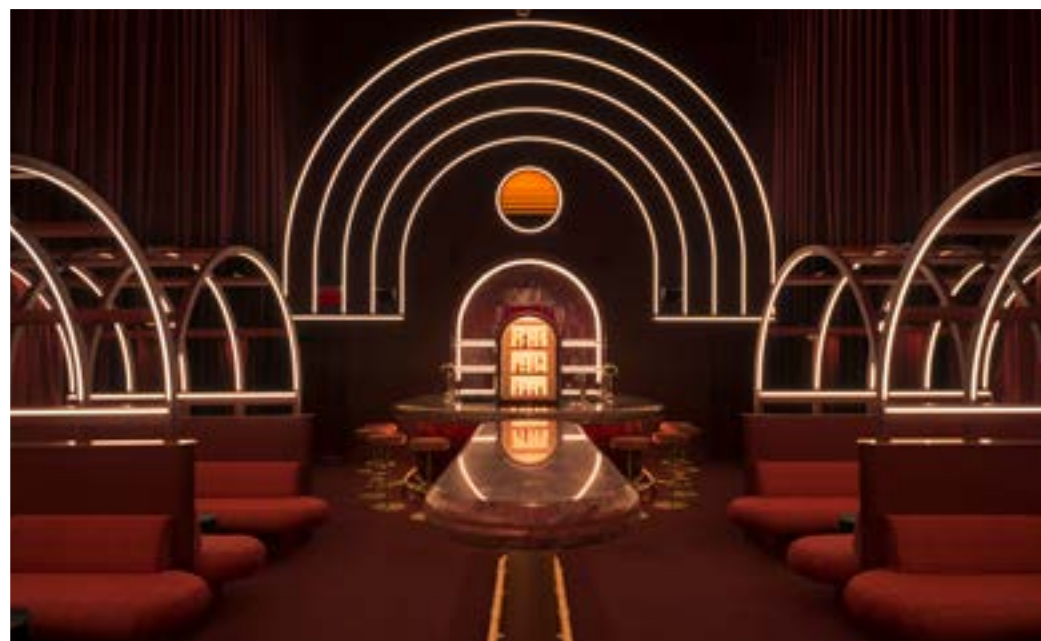

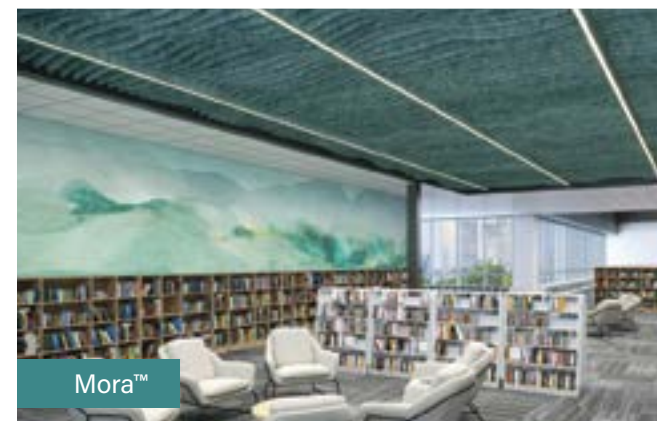
